**ORDER GRANTING SECOND AND FINAL FEE APPLICATION OF PROVINCE, LLC,
AS FINANCIAL ADVISOR FOR THE DEBTOR, FOR THE ALLOWANCE OF
COMPENSATION FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AND
REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

1 On January 9, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,
2 Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the
3 *Second and Final Fee Application of Province, LLC, as Financial Advisor for the Debtor, for the*
4 *Allowance of Compensation for Professional Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses*
5 [ECF No. 592] (the “Application”) filed by Province, LLC (“Province”), financial advisor for Front
6 Sight Management LLC (the “Debtor”) during its chapter 11 bankruptcy case. Appearances were as
7 duly noted on the record at the hearing.

8 The Court, having read and considered the Application and all evidence filed in support of
9 the Application, and other related pleadings and papers on file in this case; the Court having
10 considered the argument and representations of counsel at the hearing and other matters which the
11 Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the record in this case as
12 reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings of fact and conclusions of law on the
13 record at the hearing, which are incorporated herein by reference pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 52, as
14 made applicable pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7052 and 9014; the Court having found that notice of
15 the Application was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; the
16 Court noting that Province agreed to a voluntary reduction of its fees in the amount of \$16,384
17 pursuant to the *United States Trustee’s Notice of Voluntary Reduction in Fees with Respect to*
18 *Province LLC’s Second and Final Fee Applications* [ECF No. 616]; the Court having noted that no
19 opposition to the Application having been filed; the Court having determined that the legal and
20 factual bases set forth in the Application establish just cause for the relief sought therein; the Court
21 having determined that the relief requested in the Application is appropriate; and after due
22 deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

23 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 24 1. The Application as modified is APPROVED.
- 25 2. The fee request contained within the Application is hereby approved on a final basis
26 and allowed in the aggregate amount of **\$1,243,942.63** (“Final Award”) for the period of May 24,
27 2022 through January 9, 2023, which Final Award consists of final allowed fees in the amount of
28 \$1,241,641.05 plus reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$2,301.58.

1 3. Upon entry of this Order, BG Law LLP (“BG”), bankruptcy counsel for the Debtor
2 during its chapter 11 bankruptcy case, is instructed to pay Province its unpaid fees and expenses in
3 the amount of \$298,773.67 from the professional fee reserve maintained in BG’s settlement trust
4 account pursuant to the plan confirmation order.

5 4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the
6 implementation of this Order.
