**ORDER SUSTAINING OBJECTION TO PROOF OF CLAIM 109-1 FILED
BY STEVEN NESSEN**

On January 9, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,
Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the

1 *Objection to Proof of Claim 109-1 Filed by Steven Nessen* [ECF No. 570] (the “Objection”)¹ filed by
2 Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the “Debtor”). Pursuant to the Debtor’s
3 confirmed chapter 11 plan of reorganization and order thereon, Province, LLC, solely in its capacity
4 as the Liquidating Trustee (“Liquidating Trustee”) of the Front Sight Creditors Trust (the
5 “Liquidating Trust”), has standing to pursue the Objection. Appearances were as duly noted on the
6 record at the hearing.

7 The Court, having read and considered the Objection and all evidence filed in support of the
8 Objection; the Court having considered the argument and representations of counsel at the hearing
9 and other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation,
10 the record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings and
11 conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052
12 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that notice of the Objection
13 was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; the Court having
14 determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief
15 sought therein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

16 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Objection is sustained in its entirety.

17 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that Proof of Claim 109-1 shall be
18 RECLASSIFIED as a \$5,000 GENERAL UNSECURED CLAIM, and Claimant shall have no other
19 claim against the Debtor, its estate, or the Liquidating Trust.

20 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that any further claims filed or asserted by the
21 Claimant, including any amendments, shall be deemed disallowed without further Court order.

22 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that pursuant to Civil Rule 54(b), made applicable
23 in contested matters through Bankruptcy Rules 7054 and 9014, this Order shall be treated as a final
24 judgment with respect to Claimant and its Claim.
