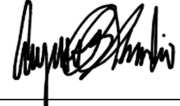

**ORDER SUSTAINING SIXTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO DUPLICATE CLAIMS**

1 On January 9, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,  
2 Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the *Sixth*  
3 *Omnibus Objection to Duplicate Claims* [ECF No. 561] (the “Omnibus Objection”)<sup>1</sup> filed by Front  
4 Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the “Debtor”). Pursuant to the Debtor’s  
5 confirmed chapter 11 plan of reorganization and order thereon, Province, LLC, solely in its capacity  
6 as the Liquidating Trustee (“Liquidating Trustee”) of the Front Sight Creditors Trust (“Liquidating  
7 Trust”), has standing to pursue the Objection. Appearances were as duly noted on the record at the  
8 hearing.

9 The Court, having read and considered the Omnibus Objection and all evidence filed in  
10 support of the Omnibus Objection; the Court having considered the argument and representations of  
11 counsel at the hearing and other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice,  
12 including, without limitation, the record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set  
13 forth its findings and conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil  
14 Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that  
15 notice of the Omnibus Objection was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further  
16 notice is required; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the  
17 Omnibus Objection establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after due deliberation and  
18 sufficient cause appearing therefor,

19 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Omnibus Objection is sustained in its entirety, except  
20 as it relates to Claim 213-1, 214-1, and 529-1 filed by claimant William Feczko. Pursuant to the  
21 *Order Approving Stipulation Resolving the Debtor’s Sixth Omnibus Objection as it Related to Claim*  
22 *Nos. 213-1, 214-1, and 529-1 filed by William Feczko* [ECF No. 583], Claim 213-1 is allowed as a  
23 GENERAL UNSECURED CLAIM in the amount of \$75,472.50, and Claim 214-1 and Claim 529-1  
24 are disallowed in their entirety.

18 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that for any Claim disallowed pursuant to this  
19 Order, Claimant forever waives such Claim against the the Debtor, its estate, the Liquidating Trustee  
20 and the Liquidating Trust.

21 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that any further claims filed or asserted by the  
22 Claimants after entry of this Order, including any amendments, shall be deemed disallowed without  
23 further Court order.

24 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that pursuant to Civil Rule 54(b), made applicable  
25 in contested matters through Bankruptcy Rules 7054 and 9014, this Order shall be treated as a final  
26 judgment with respect to Claimants and their Claims.
