**ORDER GRANTING LIQUIDATING TRUSTEE’S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER

5 Motion; the Court having considered the arguments and representations of counsel at the hearing and  
6 other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the  
7 record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings and conclusions  
8 on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052 of the  
9 Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that notice of the Motion was  
10 sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; no responses to the  
11 Motion having been filed; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in  
12 the Motion establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after due deliberation and sufficient  
13 cause appearing therefor,

14 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Motion is granted in its entirety.

15 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the general claim objection deadline of  
16 February 28, 2023 is extended through and including August 28, 2023, without prejudice to the  
17 Liquidating Trustee’s right to request a further extension for cause shown.
