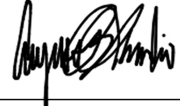

**FINAL DECREE CLOSING THE DEBTOR’S BANKRUPTCY CASE PURSUANT TO
11 U.S.C. § 350, RULE 3022 OF THE FEDERAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY
PROCEDURE AND LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 3022**

1 On July 16, 2024, at 1:30 p.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,
2 Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the
3 *Motion for Entry of Final Decree Closing the Debtor's Bankruptcy Case Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §*
4 *350, Rule 3022 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Local Bankruptcy Rule 3022*
5 [ECF No. 886] (the "Motion")¹ filed by Province, LLC, solely in its capacity as the duly authorized
6 and acting Liquidating Trustee (the "Liquidating Trustee") of the Front Sight Creditors Trust (the
7 "Trust"). Susan K. Seflin of BG Law LLP appeared on behalf of the Liquidating Trustee. Edward
8 M. McDonald appeared on behalf of the United States Trustee ("UST"). Lucas Mundell of Schwartz
9 Law, PLLC appeared on behalf of the reorganized debtor ("Reorganized Debtor"). There were no
10 other appearances.

11 The Court, having read and considered the Motion and all evidence filed in support of the
12 Motion; the Court having considered the argument and representations of counsel at the hearing and
13 other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the
14 record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings and conclusions
15 on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052 of the
16 Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that notice of the Motion was
17 sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; no responses to the
18 Motion having been filed; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in
19 the Motion establish just cause for the relief sought therein; the Court having found that the relief
20 requested in the Motion is appropriate and in accordance with the terms set forth in the Plan; and
21 after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

22 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 23 1. The Motion is granted in its entirety.
- 24 2. Upon entry of this Order, an order closing the Debtor's bankruptcy case may be
25 entered.

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28 ¹ All initial capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning ascribed to them in the Motion.

1 3. The Liquidating Trustee and the Reorganized Debtor shall file their respective post-
2 confirmation operating reports and pay their respected UST quarterly fees no later than forty-five
3 (45) days from the date the Court enters this Order.

4 4. The Liquidating Trustee shall pay UST quarterly fees of \$10,787.19 for the second
5 quarter 2024 upon entry of this Order.

6 5. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as a limit on the rights of the UST to enforce
7 collection of any unpaid quarterly fees.

8 6. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the
9 implementation of this Order.
